Abstract:

The Geneva Center for Business and Human Rights (gcbhr.org) was founded in November 2019 at the Geneva School for Economics and Management, as the first Human Rights Center at a business school in Europe.

Its mission is to challenge and empower current and future business leaders to develop sustainable business models that create value for business and society.

To advance this mission, we have developed a research methodology that integrates our focus on impact into all our workstreams.

I will illustrate the application of this methodology with our work on responsible sourcing of cobalt from the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

I will also provide an overview of GCBHR's other current activities, publications and future research plans.
